

HERITAGE OAK PARK NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

(HOPNW Sep 15, 2008)

We provide a resident volunteer night patrol for the Park. Schedules for the summer, May 1st – Oct 31st and for the winter, Nov 1st – Apr 30th are provided.

The normal patrol, for each team, is for two hours with the intention of providing ears and eyes for the police. An important part of our effort is visibility. Part of touring the Park is to stand for brief times at front and rear gates, as well as at main intersections, so that the HOPNW signs on your vehicle can be seen by any passing traffic.

The Lodge and associated buildings are usually locked at 10:00 PM. If a group, such as card players, is still there after hours, they will have made arrangements to lock up on their vacating the building. Computer users may also be in the Lodge lanai after hours.

Garages, or vehicles, left open, late at night is unfortunate, but disturbing the resident may invite more grief than you need! Information, not confrontation, is the rule.

If you suspect a trespasser, or criminal activity, call the police. Identify yourself as HOP Neighborhood Watch and give your location etc. Please copy me, if not, the office, on the following morning.
